

Town of Grant Monthly Board Meeting
Grant Town Hall – 7:00 p.m.
June 6, 2022

The monthly meeting of the Grant Town Board was held at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, June 6, 2022 at the Grant Town Hall. Roll Call: Richard Britzke, Dale Klitz, Bill Bowers, Rick Grunewald, and Sarah Knaup. Three residents and one guest were in attendance.

Chairman Britzke read the agenda which was published in *The Marion Advertiser* on June 1st, 2022. A motion was made by Bowers/Klitz to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Klitz/Bowers to approve the minutes of the May town board meeting. Motion carried.

Public Comments: Ken Huebner stated that he replaced three flowers in the garden bed at the town hall.

County Supervisor Update: Arlyn Tober stated that the county has started to work on their budget. He also stated that Kara Skarlupka is the new County Clerk. Kara replaces Pam Schmidt, who retired.

License Renewals: The board reviewed a list of the liquor, cigarette, and bartender license applications/renewals as presented for approval. A motion was made by Britzke/Bowers to approve the liquor and operator's licenses for Hidden Valley Supper Club, Blue 52, Plain Sense, LLC, and the Caroline Lions Club, and a cigarette license for Plain Sense LLC. Motion carried. The application for Ron & Donna Wuske's Barn was tabled until July. This will allow the Wuske's time to obtain their required permits through the county.

Plan Commission & Zoning: Next meeting will be July 11th at 3:00 pm at the Grant Town Hall.

Roads & Roads Maintenance-Bridge/Culvert Aid Application: Blacktopping and patching will begin this week. The 2023 Bridge & Culvert Aid Project Application was discussed. A motion was made by Bowers/Klitz to approve the 2023 Bridge & Culvert Aid Project Application offered through the Shawano County Highway Department. Motion carried.

Town Hall Reservations & Maintenance: We have received several compliments on the new roof. A motion was made by Britzke/Klitz to approve town hall reservations for Mike Malueg on July 9th and Janell Verg on September 10th. Motion carried.
