

Town of Grant Monthly Board Meeting
Grant Town Hall – 7:00 pm
July 11, 2022

The monthly meeting of the Grant Town Board was held on Monday, July 11, 2022 at 7:00 pm. Roll call: Richard Britzke, Dale Klitz, Bill Bowers, Rick Grunewald, and Sarah Knaup. Four residents and six guests were in attendance.

The agenda was published in *The Marion Advertiser* on July 6, 2022. A motion was made by Klitz/Bowers to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Bowers/Britzke to approve the minutes of the June town board meeting. Motion carried.

Public Comments: Ken Huebner commented that there was a young man fishing from the middle of the bridge on County Road G, and that there was no sign up indicating no fishing from the bridge. A motion was made by Bowers/Britzke to contact the county highway department and have a “no fishing from bridge” sign put up. Motion carried. George Lenzner introduced himself. He is running for Shawano County Sheriff. The primary election will be August 9th.

Caroline Aces 4-H Club: Megan Suehring, Rachel Wudstrack, and Taya Jannusch presented an idea to purchase new playground equipment to place on the town hall property. The Caroline Aces received a generous donation and they would like to pay for the equipment, installation, and new wood chips. A motion was made by Klitz/Britzke to allow the Caroline Aces 4-H Club to pay for the new equipment and all installation. Motion carried.

County Supervisor Update: Arlyn Tober stated that the county had received their second ARPA payment, and that the county has started working on the budget.

Plan Commission and Zoning – Wuske Conditional Use Permit, Ted & Gina Jobe Zone Change, and Luke & Sarah Hershberger Conditional Use permit: Wuske conditional use permit will be tabled until August. A motion was made by Klitz/Bowers to approve a conditional use permit for Luke & Sarah Hershberger. Motion carried. A motion was made by Bowers/Britzke to approve the zone change for Ted & Gina Jobe. Motion carried. Next meeting for the Plan Commission will be August 1st at 3:00 pm.

Approve liquor, beer, and operator’s licenses for Wuske Barn: Tabled until August.

Roads and Roads Maintenance: Blacktopping and chip sealing are currently being done.

Town Hall Reservations and Maintenance: A motion was made by Britzke/Klitz to approve town hall reservations for Bob Malueg on July 8th, 2023 and Linda Fritz on September 11th, 2022. Motion carried.

Caroline Baseball Diamond: Red granite was laid and a light pole was fixed.

Caroline Dam: No comments

Sanitary District: Jeremy Karst will be moving out of the town. His replacement will be approved in August.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Bowers/Britzke to approve checks 9920-9937 in the regular checking. Motion carried.

Adjourn: A motion was made by Britzke/Klitz to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.
