

Town of Grant Monthly Board Meeting
Grant Town Hall – 7:00 p.m.
September 12, 2022

The monthly meeting of the Grant Town Board was held at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, September 12, 2022 at the Grant Town Hall. Roll Call: Richard Britzke, Bill Bowers, Dale Klitz, Rick Grunewald, and Sarah Knaup. Six residents and one guest were in attendance.

Chairman Britzke read the agenda which was published in *The Marion Advertiser* on September 7, 2022. A motion was made by Britzke/Klitz to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Bowers/Klitz to approve the minutes of the August town board meeting. Motion carried.

Public Comment Period: Ken Huebner stated that the cat situation on Uecker Street has improved.

County Supervisor Update: Jerry Erdmann stated that the county is working on the budget. He also stated that Shawano County saw an increase in revenue due to sales tax. The county approved the ordering of 10 new squad cars, and they will be selling 7 old squad cars. Estimates for the Shawano library improvement/replacement are coming in, and the landscaping at the courthouse will be finished in the Spring.

Plan Commission & Zoning – Kent Kersten Zone Changes/Conditional Use Permit, Malueg

Zoning: A motion was made by Bowers/Britzke to approve a zone change for Kent Kersten. Motion carried. A motion was made by Klitz/Britzke to approve a zone change and conditional use permit for Kent Kersten. Motion carried. No action taken on Malueg zoning. Property at W12793 County Road M: The town board has received multiple complaints from residents about the amount of junk and the burning of garbage on the property. A motion was made by Klitz/Bowers to send the resident a letter about cleaning up the property. Motion carried.

Approve Ordinance 2022-01 Open Burning Regulations Ordinance: A motion was made by Britzke/Bowers to approve ordinance 2022-01 Open Burning Regulations Ordinance. Motion carried. A motion was made by Britzke/Bowers to send letters to three residents who have been burning prohibited materials. Motion carried.

Roads & Roads Maintenance: Shouldering will be completed on East Campfire Road. Fall banners will be put up within the next week.

Town Hall Reservation & Maintenance: A motion was made by Klitz/Bowers to approve town hall reservations for Merry Salzman September 17th, Carrie Aus September 18th, Jamie Holbrook October 23rd, Don Pockat November 13th, Char Breitenfeldt December 3rd, and Patti Drefahl May 27th, 2023. Motion carried.
