January 6, 2025

The monthly meeting of the Grant Town Board was held at 7:00 pm on Monday, January 6, 2025 at the Grant Town Hall. Roll Call: Richard Britzke, Bill Bowers, Dale Klitz, Kayla Jung, and Sarah Knaup. Six residents and one guest were in attendance.
